## The Results

The results came on the 3rd July, so seven working days after the scan. The GP I got them from had clearly never heard of KFS before so never mentioned that bit and skimmed the rest of the results. When I see my actual GP I will discuss where we are going from here with her then in terms of treatment etc.

My C3-C6 vertebrae have the degenerative effects of dehydration, hernias and osteophytes at the adjacent endplates. These accumulatively have resulted in the narrowing of the anterior space in front of the spinal canal.

I have concluded that the pain, numbness and weakness in my arms is a result of compression from the hernias and osteophytes, however the hernias in themselves can get better (being optimistic here) which will hopefully improve the symptoms.

The narrowing of the anterior space in front of the spinal canal I believe is what is the root source of my headaches and random sensations in my head when they come. If anyone knows any different or has a different interpretation of the results please do let me know.

My C5, C6, C7 and T1 vertebrae are the ones that are fused together with right hemivertebrae. My spinal canal itself is normal and the nerves etc. are passing through it normally at this time too.
